Dampening Roller Cleaner

Uses

Proper performance of modern continuous dampening systems depends on the properties and cleanliness of the dampening rollers. In alcohol free printing, there tends to be an increased build-up of ink on the dampening rollers. This build-up desensitizes the surfaces of rollers reducing their hydrophilic nature. Böttcherin FR-1000 is a special wash for removal of ink build-up on dampening pan rollers, metering rollers, chrome rollers, and ceramic rollers in continuous dampening systems. FR-1000 desensitizes both rubber, ceramic, and chrome roller surfaces.

Characteristics

- Easy application, supplied in handy 1 liter screw-top cans
- High ink dissolving power
- Non-water miscible
- Does not accumulate in fountain solution
- Will not affect the print process
- Fast wetting of dampening rollers after use
- Leaves no residue
- Fast evaporation
- Contains no aromatics, contains no acetone

Application

With the press stationary, apply Böttcherin FR-1000 to the dampening rollers with a clean rag. Keep rag moist with FR-1000 and wipe rollers until completely free of contaminants. Wear protective gloves during application. Follow all press safety procedures.

Use as needed to keep dampening rollers free of ink, grease, and other contaminants.

Marking

Böttcherin FR-1000 is classified and marked according to EC-Directive 88/379 EEC - in its latest version.
